



GODDESS DIANA ARTEMIS

(ACTS 19:27)

Continuing with the theme of Greek paganism after posting on Clement of Alexandria, I wanted to go a bit further into some of the cults mentioned by the Apostle Paul and Clement.

We will now explore the ancient pagan worship of the Goddess Diana Artemis. First it is important to note that this form of women and pagan worship was, and still is in certain satanic circles, a global problem:

"Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost **throughout all Asia**, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that **they be no gods, which are made with hands**: so that not only this our craft is in danger to be set at nought; **BUT ALSO THAT THE TEMPLE OF THE GREAT GODDESS DIANA SHOULD BE DESPISED**, and her magnificence should be destroyed, whom **all Asia and the world worshippeth**.

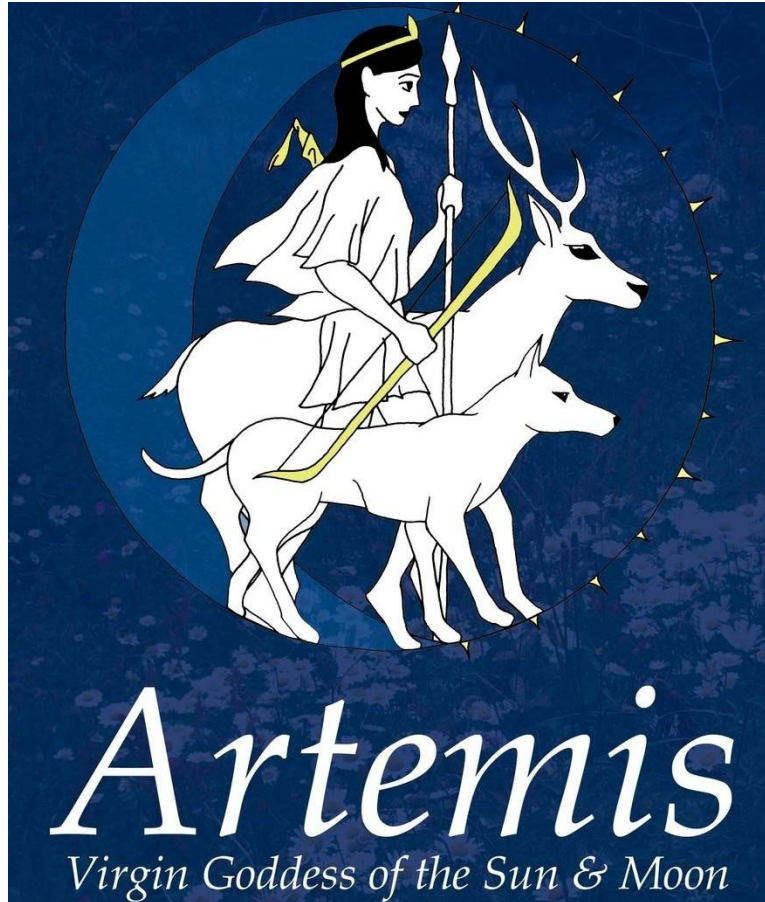
