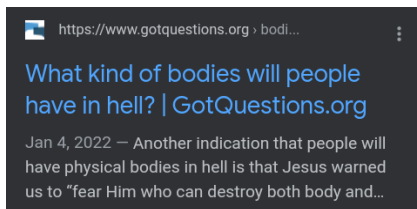

The phrase "**gnash the teeth**" is found in [Acts 7:54](#), in the story of the stoning of Stephen. The phrase was an expression of anger of the Sanhedrin towards Stephen before the stoning.

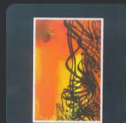
